Course Description: This high-intensity course is a comprehensive introduction to the tactical skills utilized by SWAT officers. This training is designed for officers newly assigned to SWAT teams, or those aspiring to. Topics covered include room clearing; breaching tactics; team movement; tactical shooting; shield work; and tactical shooting skills. Officers will practice the tactics and techniques in several different environments and scenarios.

Equipment: Full duty and/or tactical belt, body armor, eye protection, handgun, long gun, Simunition protective gear, 350 rounds of handgun ammo, ballistic helmet, ballistic shield, knee pads – and any other personal tactical equipment as desired. (We may be able to provide some of the tactical equipment if officers don't have all the gear).
