**520 HOUR – LAW ENFORCEMENT BASIC TRAINING ACADEMY  
January 21, 2014 through April 25, 2014**

Applications are currently being accepted for the law enforcement recruit academy session scheduled to commence January 21, 2014. Pre-service students who successfully complete this training are deemed “certifiable” for a position in law enforcement by the State of Wisconsin, Law Enforcement Standards Board for a period of three years. Requirements to attend this training include:

1. Must have completed at least 60 credits from a fully-accredited college.
2. Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
3. Must be a United States citizen.
4. Must possess a valid Wisconsin driver’s license (or one recognized by the Wisconsin DOT).
5. Must undergo a criminal history/background check free of convictions that would prohibit possession of a firearm.
6. Must submit a medical authorization form, signed by a physician, allowing participation in vigorous physical activity.
7. Must successfully complete an oral interview before a panel of law enforcement professionals.

Training will be conducted Monday through Friday from 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, at the MATC Oak Creek Campus located at 6665 South Howell Avenue, Oak Creek. There will be four 12-hour sessions scheduled to conclude at 9:30 PM and two 8-hour Saturday sessions.

Total cost, including firearms rental, uniform, books, equipment and scenario evaluation fee is approximately \$3,300.

1. **Candidates who desire to enroll must download and complete an Application for Enrollment (DJ-LE-327) from <https://wilenet.org>. Written responses to the 3 essay questions in section 6 of the DJ-LE 327 Application are required.**
2. **Official Transcripts from the college(s), where the applicant obtained their 60+ credits.**
3. **A signed, filled out [Criminal History Background Check/Driver Vehicle Record Check form \(accessible by this link\)](#).**
4. **A check or money order for \$7.00 made out to MATC for the Criminal History Background Check.**

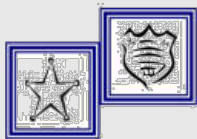
