Laboratory Safety

- 1. Do not enter the laboratory unless the instructor is present. Never work in the laboratory alone. Begin laboratory exercises only when told to by the instructor.
- 2. Know the location of safety equipment and its proper use. Know how you will react in a safety incident involving you or a classmate.
- 3. Absolutely no smoking, eating, drinking, application of cosmetics or lip balm in the laboratory.
- 4. Handle all reagents, biologicals, supplies and equipment as instructed. Treat all organisms as potential pathogens.
- 5. Do not touch you hands to your face, lips, eyes, nose, etc. while in the laboratory.
- 6. Wash your hands whenever contaminated, completing a laboratory assignment, or leaving the laboratory for any reason. Cover all hand injuries with a band-aid or gloves.
- 7. Laboratory coats will be worn in the lab. No lab coat, no laboratory.
- 8. Open toed shoes, sandals, or canvas type shoes are not to be worn.
- 9. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back.
- 10. Consider your laboratory counter to be contaminated unless you have properly cleaned it.
- 11.Clean your counter immediately before and after each use, and after a biologic or chemical spill.
- 12. Protect personal property to prevent contamination. Bring only what is needed to class. Use the lockers provided by the school to store all other personal items.
- 13. Always recap or close any reagent or biological container immediately after each use.
- 14.Do not carry open containers of biologicals or reagents around the classroom. Obtain the necessary laboratory materials from the front of the lab and return directly to your lab station.
- 15. Operate laboratory equipment only after receiving proper instruction.
- 16. Dispose of all chemical, biological, and sharps waste into the proper receptacle. Dispose of regular trash into the normal room trash receptacle.

17. No non-class members are allowed in the laboratory for safety and liability reasons.
18.Immediately report all laboratory incidents to the instructor.
